The Montgomery County Board of Education convened in a regular monthly meeting on Monday, August 1, 2022, at 6:30 pm in the Montgomery County Schools Boardroom. Board members present were Steve W. Chairman DeBerry called upon Wade Auman for the After School Program presentation. Mr. Auman described it as a "pay to stay model." Mr. Auman explained for the last three years we have been under a 21st Century grant. We applied this year but were denied. Typically, this grant has a buffer year between grants. We need to offer this kind of program because surrounding charter schools are. We have lost students in the past because we did not have after-school options for parents. Mr. Auman shared his proposal for kindergarten through fifth grade students. Pre-K students will not be available due to the restraints of Pre-K licensing. The board discussed offering a fee waiver for families with multiple students and staffing options. Mr. DeBerry asked for a motion for approval. Bryan Dozier made a motion with Cindy Taylor seconding. The motion carried unanimously with the board.

Chairman DeBerry called upon Dr. Dale Ellis for Captial Projects. Dr. Ellis shared the list below that was submitted for repairs this coming year.

Chairman DeBerry called upon Dr. Dale Ellis for his Superintendent's Remarks. Dr. Ellis has spoken to fellow superintendents about their staff shortages. Usually, at this time of year we have ten or twelve vacancies. It seems every year we hire a couple from Moore County and lose a couple to Moore County. We are doing the Texas shuffle right now. Unfortunately, we probably will be doing this

through August and the rest of September. I want to say how proud I am of the good job our principals have done. They have really worked hard hiring staff. When you talk to other school districts they have 30 to 40 openings. We just have a handful. I feel good about that. Our principals, Tracy and his HR staff have done a tremendous job staffing our school system. I am proud of them.

Bryan Dozier added as an employer he knows how hard it is to hire people now.

Chairman DeBerry then asked for a motion to go into closed session to discuss personnel and consult the board attorney. Bryan Dozier made the motion, with Ann Evans seconding. The board approved entering closed session unanimously.

Upon return to open session, Chairman DeBerry asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Bryan Dozier made the motion with Tommy Blake seconding; the meeting was duly adjourned.
