RESOLUTION

Upon recommendation, the Montgomery County Schools Board of Education approves the plan to provide the East Montgomery High School Automotive Program an area to store vehicles being used in their program as outlined in the attached page.

Request Fenced Area for Auto Tech at EMHS

In accordance with NATEF Standards (National Automotive Technicians Education Foundation) we must provide a fenced in area of approximately 8400 square feet to be able to store automobiles that the students are working on in the Automotive Program at East Montgomery. This must be done to qualify the program for NATEF Certification next year. The best area available to accommodate our needs is the front of what is now pasture area for the EMHS Agriculture Program.

We met with Adam Garner, Agriculture Instructor at East. He has agreed to allow us to use this area provided he could enlarge his pasture back in the direction of East Middle School. We would like to leave a buffer all the way around the property back to the power line at EMS. This would continue around on the side where the tennis courts are located. I have spoken with Coach Blake and Principal Donna Kennedy to get their approval. Mr. Garner would like to be able to keep enough of the proceeds from cutting the timber from the property to be able to finish the pasture for his animals. We estimate the proceeds to be somewhere in the range of \$4000.00.

This will be done at no cost to the school system. It will allow for expansion of our Agriculture program and to meet the requirements for certification of our Automotive program.
