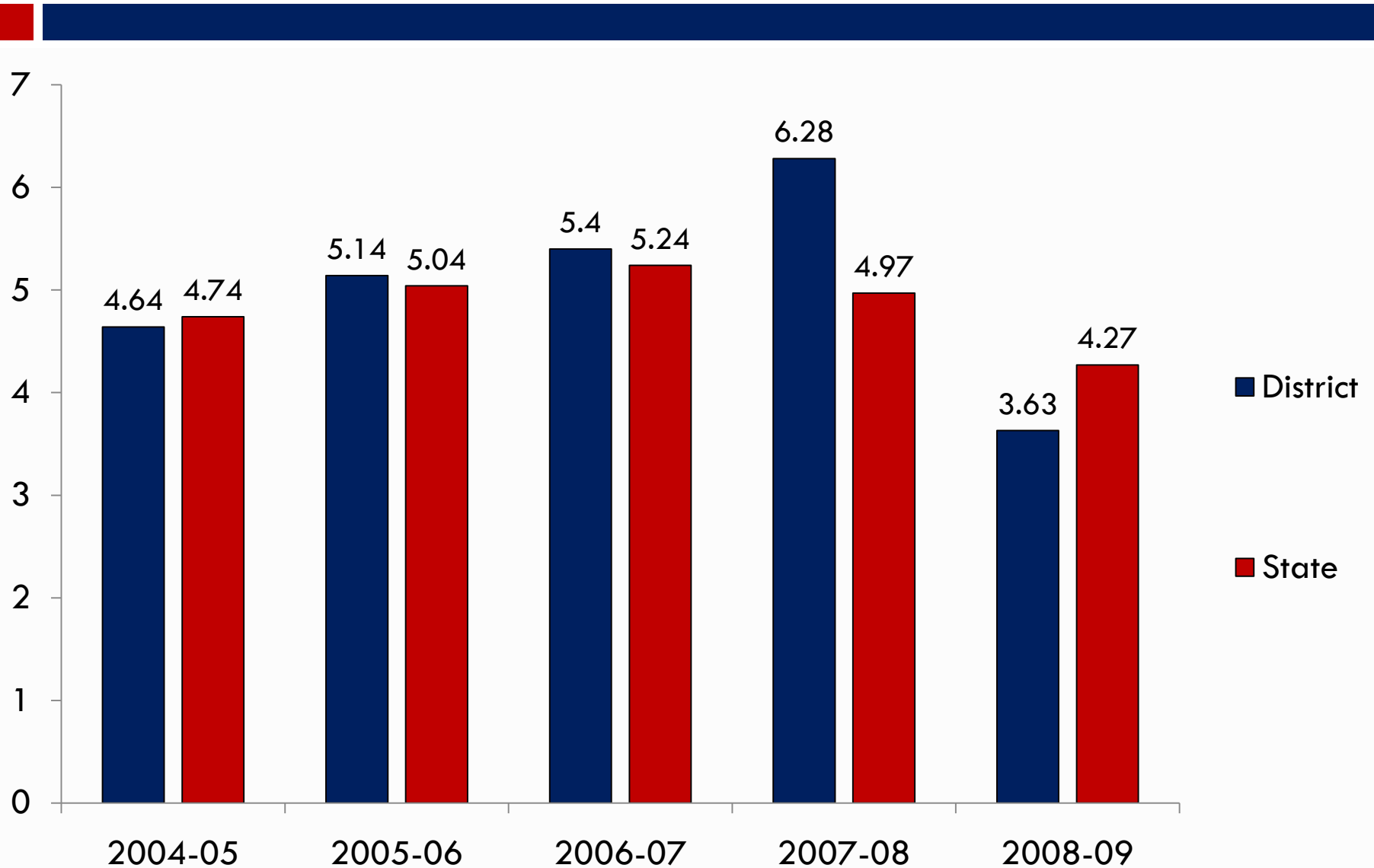

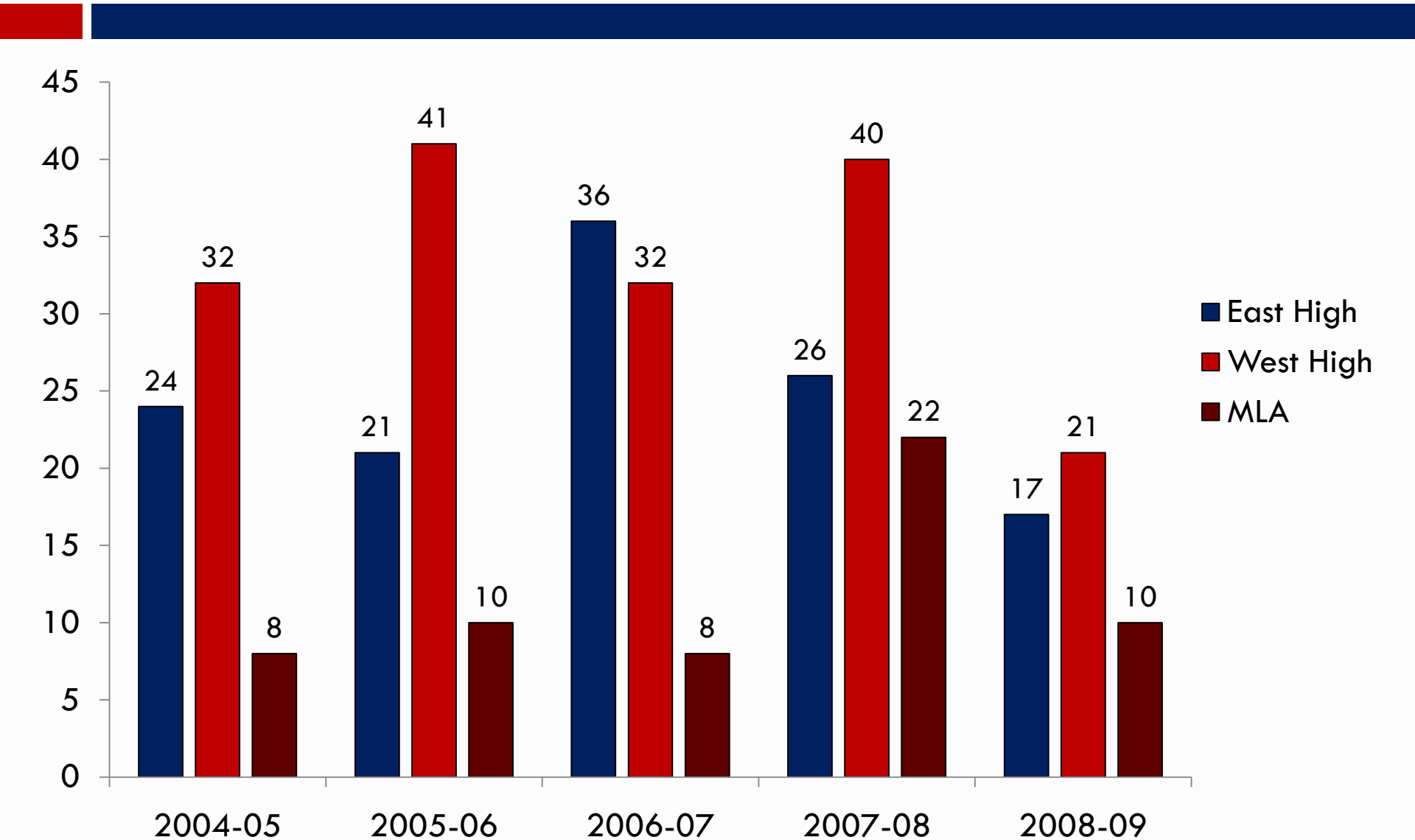
Montgomery County Schools Dropout Percentages

Comparison by District and State

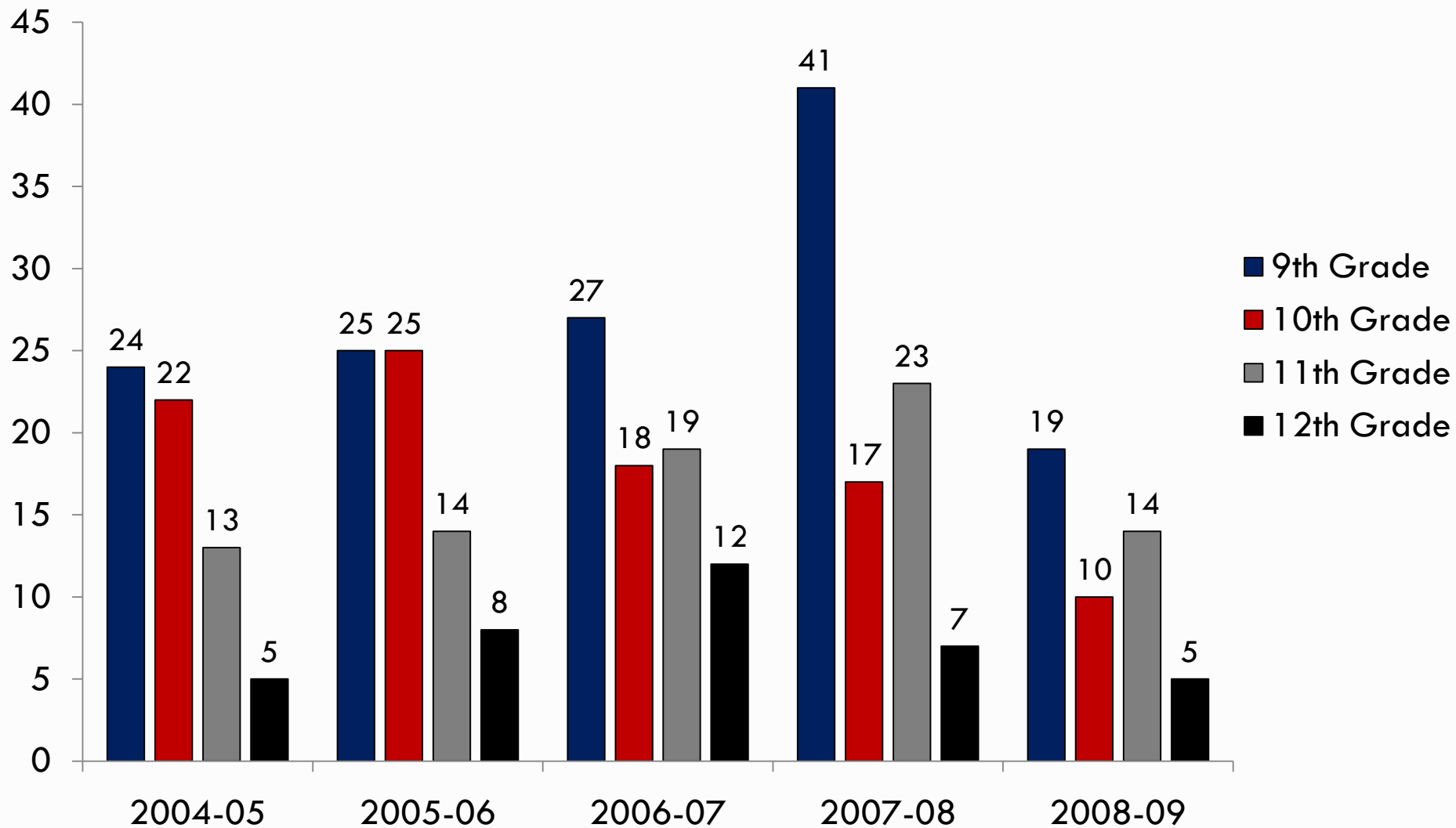

Montgomery County Schools Dropouts Comparison by School 2004-2009



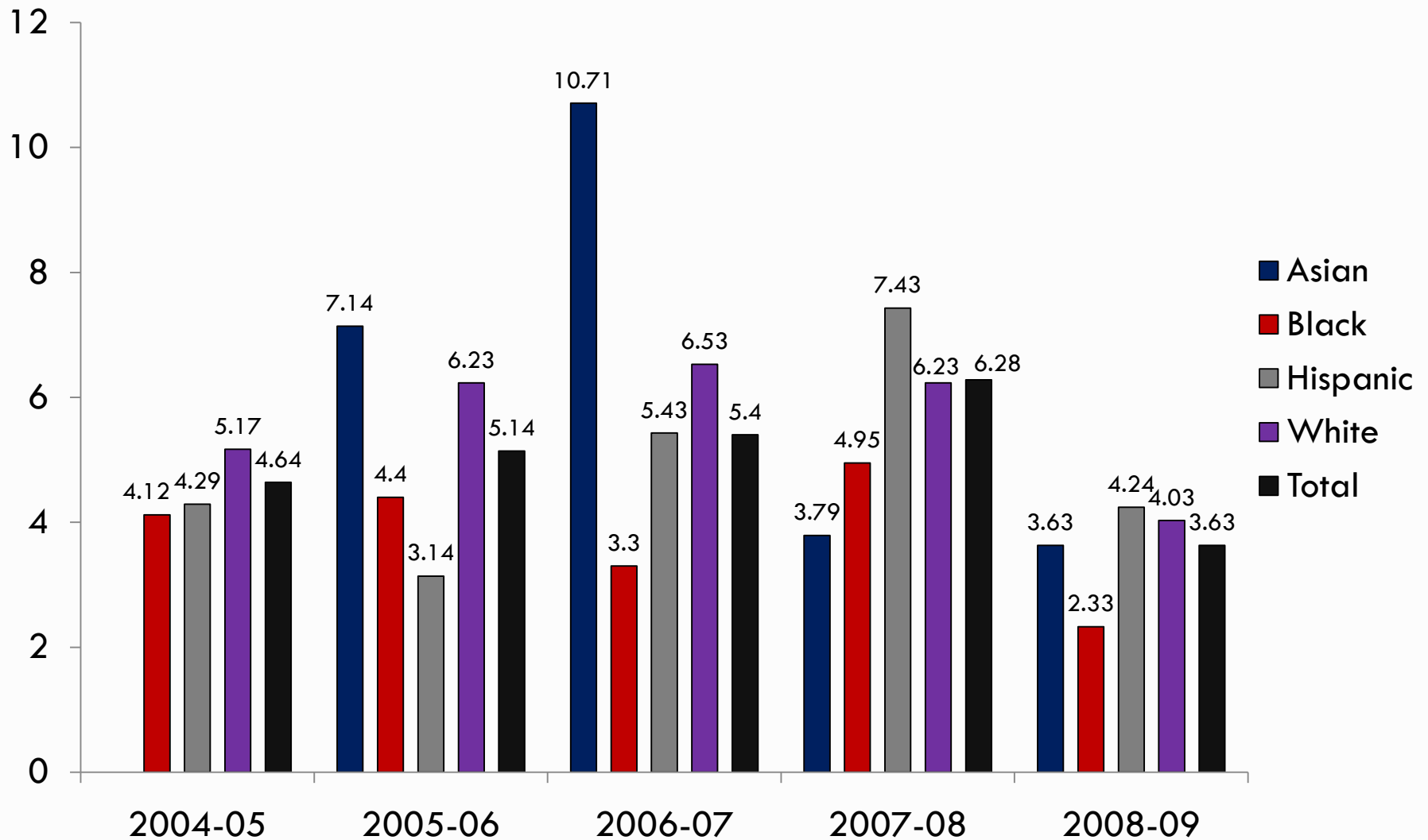
Montgomery County Schools Dropouts Comparison by Grade 2004-2009



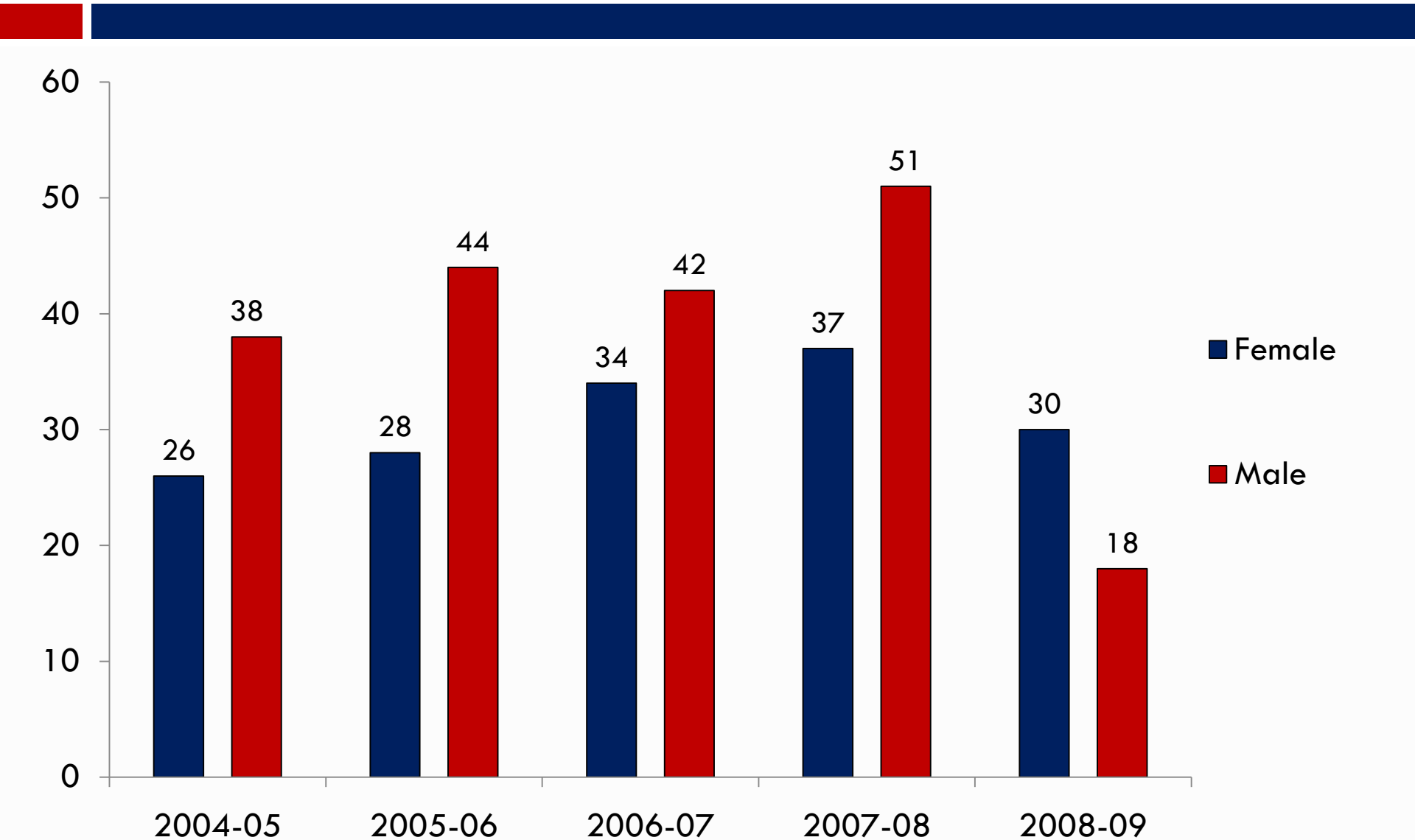
Montgomery County Schools Dropout Percentages

Comparison by Ethnicity

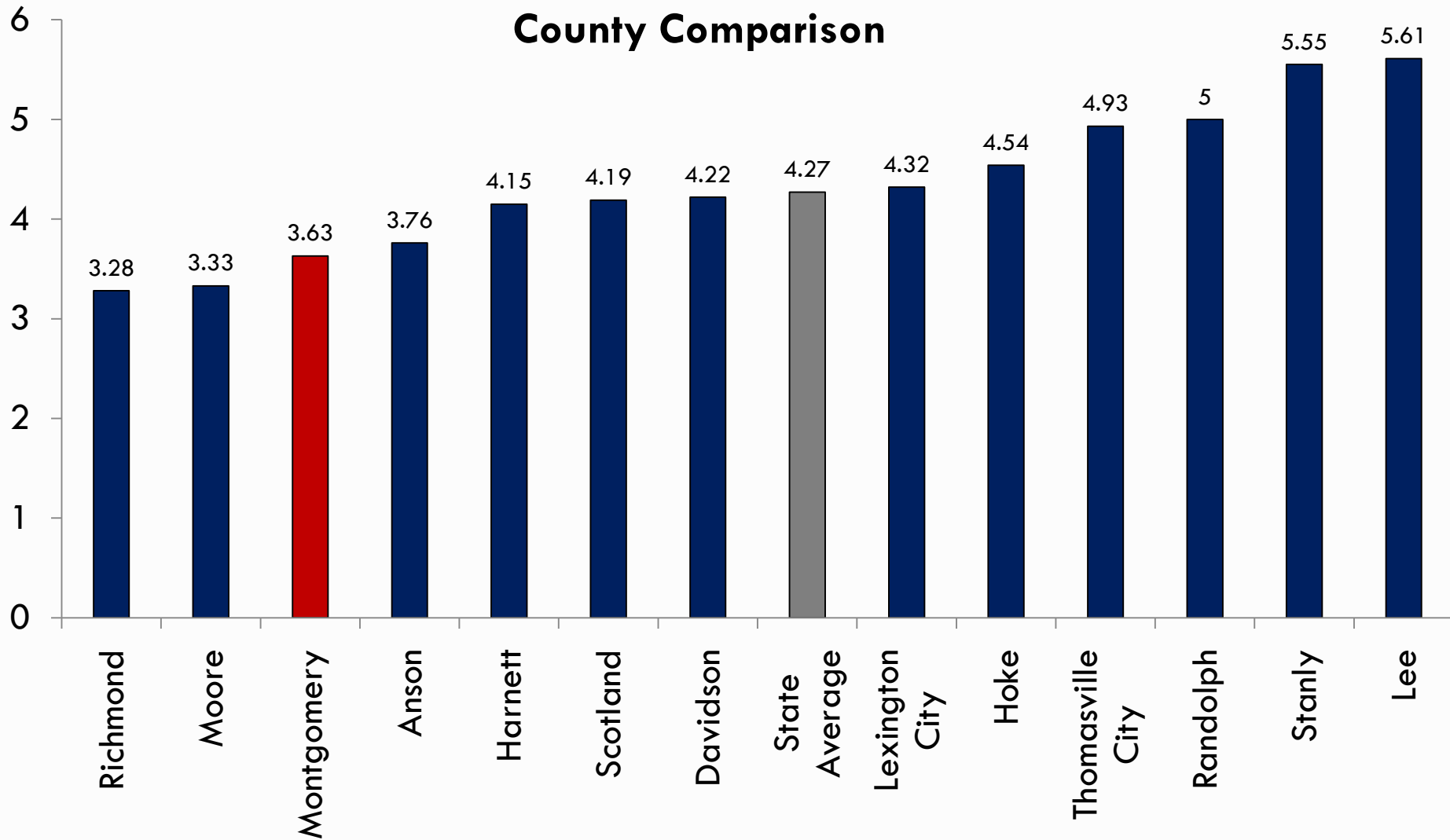

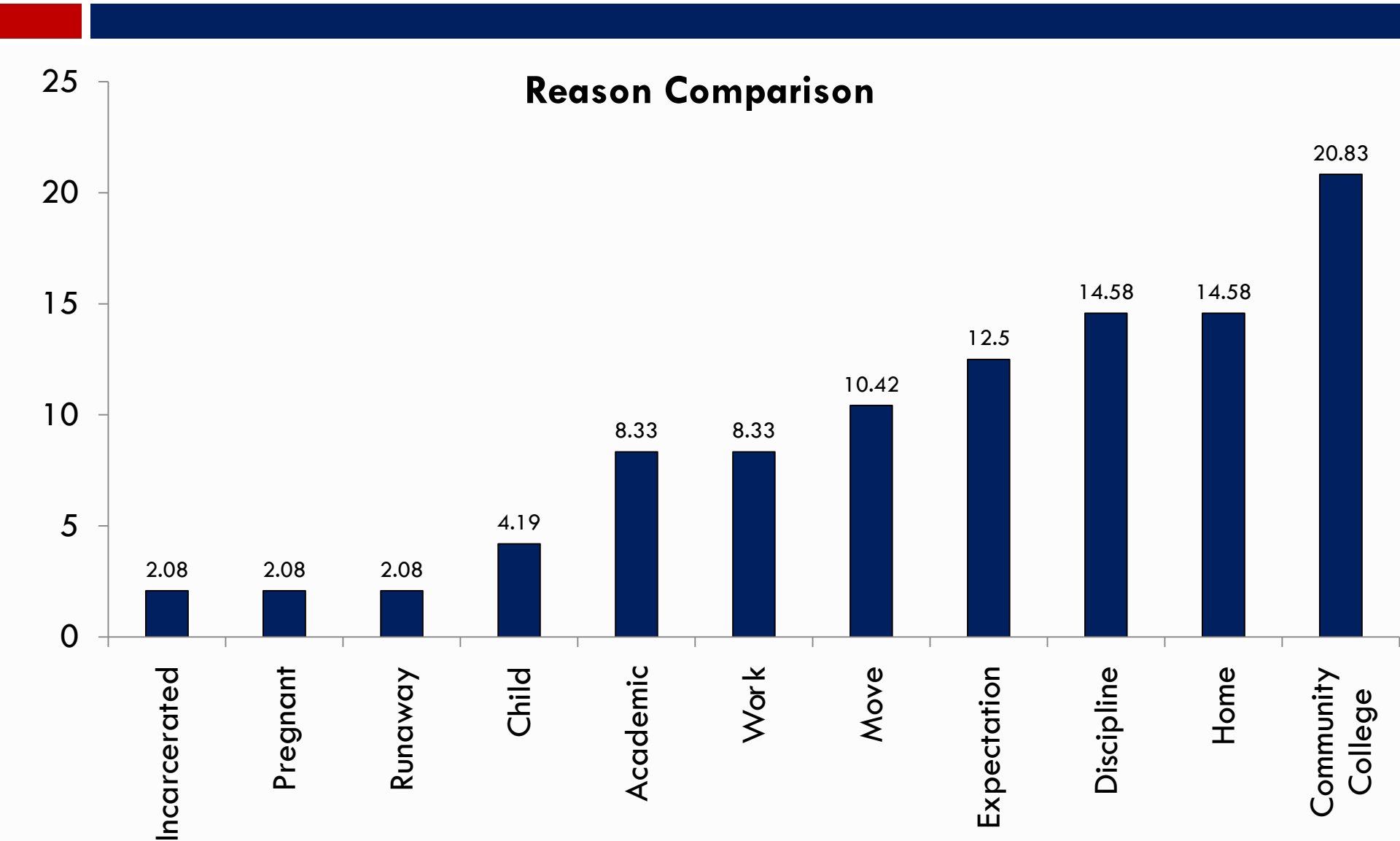
Montgomery County Schools Dropouts Comparison by Gender 2004-2009

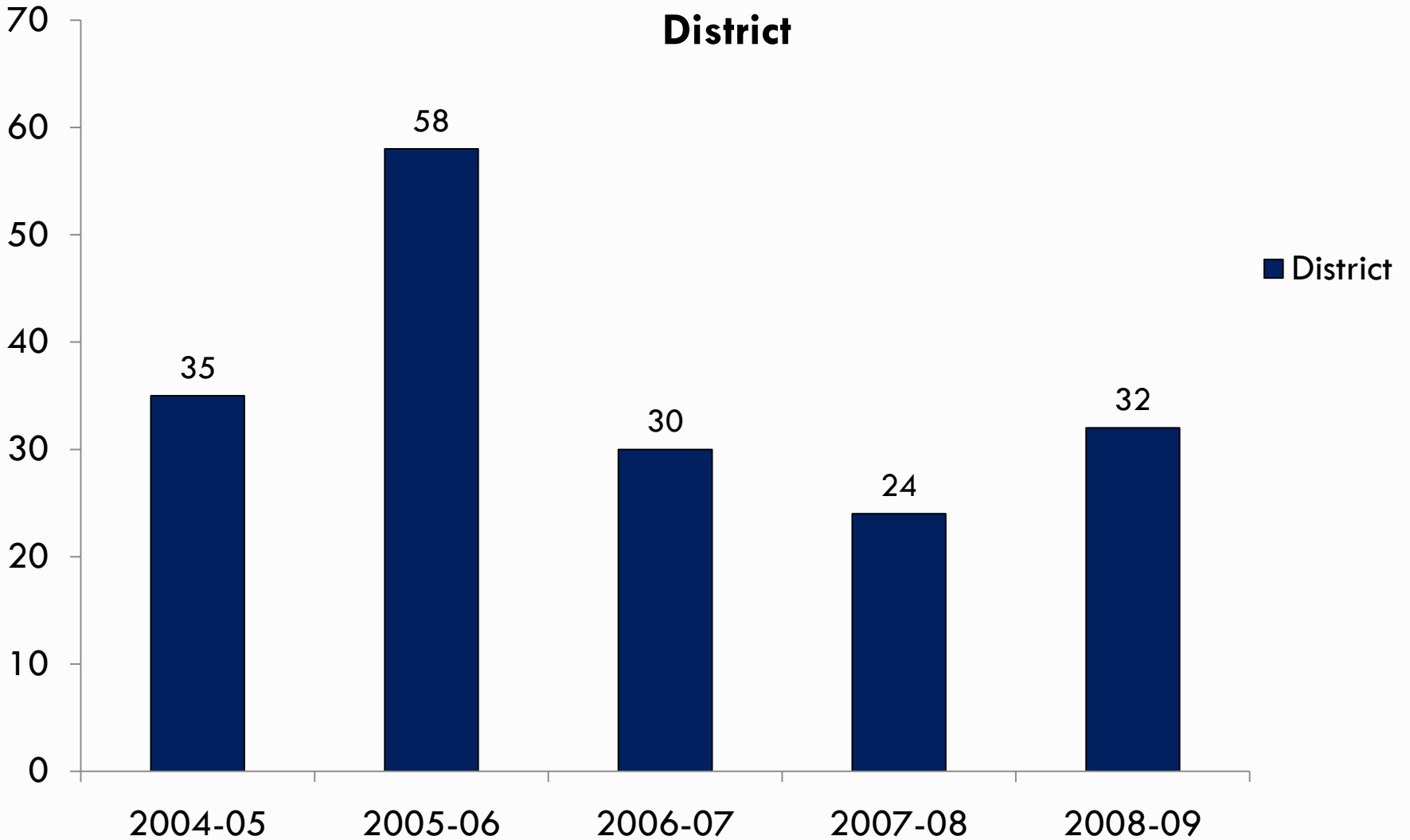

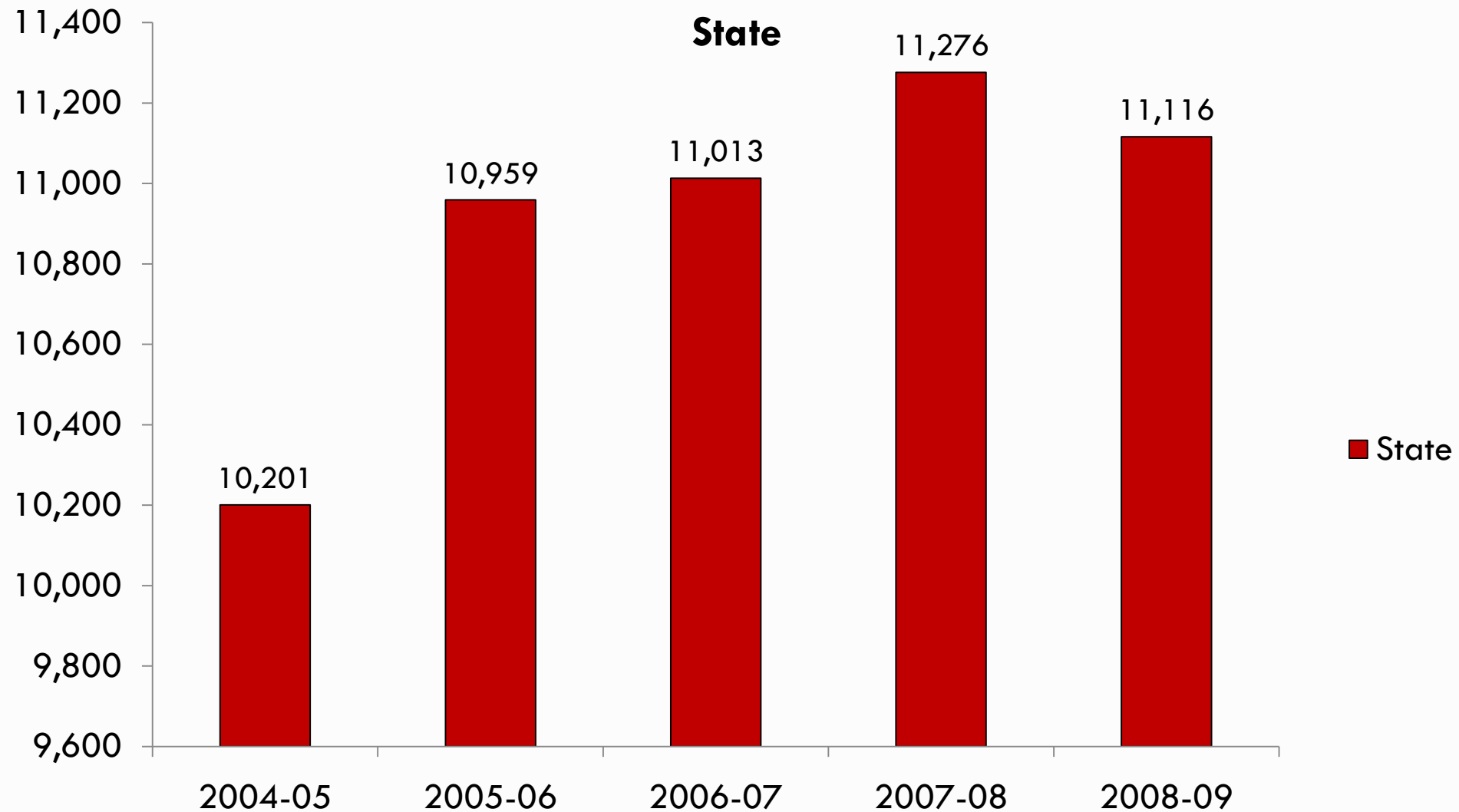
