Why is NC Transitioning to Online Assessments?

- One-item per test page
- Changeable font size
- Foreground/Background color scheme
- Virtual highlighter, calculator
- Computer Reads Test Aloud—Student Controlled
 Accommodation
 - (Note: Headphones are required unless one-on-one.)
- Shorter Tests (Smart Tests will be adaptive to students' answers)

- Grades 3-5 and High School Formative Assessments

New in 2012-13

- Computer Adaptive Online Assessments:
 - Science Grades 5 and 8
 - All EOCs (Math I, Biology, and English II)

- Online Assessments:
 - Mathematics Grades 3-8
 - ELA Grades 3-8
- Paper/Pencil Assessments:
 - NCEXTEND1
