MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

U.S. AIR FORCE JROTC PROGRAM AND WEST MONTGOMERY HIGH SCHOOL

SUBJECT: Memorandum of Understanding between U.S. Air force Junior ROTC program and West Montgomery H.S.

- The purpose of this memorandum is to document an understanding between the parties involved. Parties include U.S. Air Force Junior ROTC program and West Montgomery H.S.
- A partnership between the parties mutually supports the mission and goals of each
 organization and will provide additional resources to accomplish training events without
 additional liability concerns. USAFJROTC SASI and West Montgomery H.S. (WMHS) have
 reached this understanding.
- 3. WMHS will create opportunities for cadets to participate in marksmanship activities in conjunction with the AFJROTC curriculum.
- 4. USAF JROTC Instructors will support marksmanship activities to include classroom instruction and participation in marksmanship training involving firing on ranges.
- 5. The following controls will be established with regards to the rifle range:
 - a. Use will be limited to AFJROTC Cadets during prescribed times and under direct supervision of instructors and range officers.
 - b. Access Control will be maintained by instructors and range control officers.
 - c. Maintenance of the Range will be conducted by cadets under the supervision of instructors and range control officers.
 - d. Hours the range may be used will be 3:00 PM to 4:30 PM during weekdays or 8:00 AM -3:00 PM on selected Saturdays.
 - e. Caliber of ammunition: .177 pellet
 - f. Types of rifles to be used: Daisy Model 853.
 - g. Maintenance responsibilities: rifles will be cleaned immediately after final use each day and facilities will be returned to pre use condition after each session.
- 6. The following safety rules will be in effect:

- a. All Junior ROTC Instructors will comply with the regulator guidelines outlined by US Air Force Organization, Administration, Operation, Training and Support with respect to marksmanship training.
- b. Air rifle marksmanship will only be conducted by certified JROTC instructors or coaches approved through AF JROTC.
- c. Instructors will not conduct JROTC air rifle marksmanship training with students other than JROTC cadets. Cadets must have completed LET Unit 7, Lesson 2 and successfully passed the test as well as understand and possess the Cadet Safety Pledge.
- d. Prior to conduction marksmanship training the Senior Aerospace Science Instructor (SASI) will ensure compliance with all Air Force regulatory requirements as well as state and municipal laws and school system policies.
- e. Security of equipment: Air rifles and pellets must be stored under double lock security with access to only authorized personnel.
- 7. The school and USAF SASI continue to recognize that marksmanship training remains a wholly voluntary program for JROTC cadets.
