MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES

September 10, 2018

The Montgomery County Board of Education convened in its regular monthly meeting on Monday, September 10, 2018 at 6:30 pm at Mt. Gilead Elementary. Board members present were Steven W. DeBerry – Chair, Tommy Blake – Vice Chair, Jesse Hill, Tommy Blake, Sandra Miller and Bryan Dozier. Shirley Threadgill and Ann Long were absent.

Chairman DeBerry called the meeting to order and moved to adopt the agenda as shown. Sandra Miller made the motion with Jesse Hill seconding. The agenda was accepted with unanimous approval from the board.

Chairman DeBerry read a devotional reminding us that things always work out.

Mt. Gilead Elementary students Chloe Ellis and Marian Bowden led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

No one signed up to address the board during the public comment period.

Superintendent Ellis recognized Ashley Williamson from West Middle School. Mr. Williamson was awarded the DARE Educator of the Year award at the June DARE association conference.

Mt. Gilead Elementary teacher Sharon Sides discussed notebooks in the classroom. She implemented them last year in her first grade classroom. The notebooks are used to keep samples from writing to see where the students start and to see their improvement at the end of the year. The notebooks also keep up with students' behavior and academic goals. Mrs. Sides shares the writing samples with parents during conferences, to highlight the improvements of their child.

Dr. Takeda LeGrand presented a graduation review for Montgomery Learning Academy. The number of students who did not graduate within four years from MLA for the 2018-19 school year was thirteen. This was up from the previous year's eleven. Principal Amy Reynolds is keeping a close watch on the data. Information will be shared with the board each year. This item was an action item. Sandra Miller made the motion to approve with Tommy Blake seconding.

Superintendent Ellis asked the board for approval of Policy #4601 Collection of Student Fees and Charges. Over the past two board meetings, feedback has been gathered and changes have been made to this policy. A letter discussing school system changes, a signature page, a copy of the new policy and the poverty guidelines for 2018 (for fee waiver) was given to parents at open house. This year, there will be a technology fee of twenty-five dollars for kindergarten through second grade and forty dollars for third through twelfth grade. This includes insurance to cover each device. Sandra Miller made the motion to approve the policy change, with Tommy Blake seconding. The board approved the change unanimously.

Superintendent Ellis presented an update on construction at the site. The CTE building is behind schedule due to weather and footing issues. The high school progress has been good focusing on underground utilities and footings. It remains on schedule. Dr. Ellis said the site is easier to access if any board members would like a tour.

During *Superintendent Remarks*, Superintendent Ellis commented that Hurricane Florence was approaching and severe weather was in the forecast for our area at the end of the week. There will be shelter set up by the Red Cross at Page Street Elementary, with bus service available. The governor has declared a state of emergency, so the state will cover funds used for this event. With parents depending upon us keeping their kids safe, we will start making calls home tomorrow. This is a significant storm to watch. If a shelter is needed on the East Side of the county, East Montgomery is the chosen location.

Chairman DeBerry then asked for a motion to go into closed session to discuss personnel. Sandra Miller made the motion, with Jesse Hill seconding. The board approved entering into closed session unanimously.

After returning from closed session, Chairman DeBerry asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. With a motion by Bryan Dozier and a second by Tommy Blake, the meeting was duly adjourned.

The next regular meeting will be held on Monday, October 1, 2018 at 6:30 pm at the Central

Office Boardroom.
