

The board encourages employees to contribute their ideas for the betterment of the school district. School employees will be asked to help with developing policies, administrative procedures, and goals and objectives, and with planning curricula, services, budgets and facilities.

In devising rules and procedures for the operation of the schools, administrators shall seek the suggestions of those employees who will be affected by such provisions. When desirable, professional employees will be given an opportunity to contribute to curriculum development and to recommend policies and administrative procedures that pertain to students and instruction.

The superintendent shall develop channels for communicating ideas among employees, the administration and the board, and will inform the board of staff opinions when presenting recommendations for board actions.
