MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES

August 6, 2018

The Montgomery County Board of Education convened in its regular monthly meeting on Monday, August 6, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. Board members present were Steven W. DeBerry – Chair, Tommy Blake – Vice Chair, Jesse Hill, Ann Long, Tommy Blake, Shirley Threadgill and Bryan Dozier. Sandra Miller was absent.

Chairman DeBerry called the meeting to order and moved to adopt the agenda as shown. Ann Long made the motion with Jesse Hill seconding. The agenda was accepted with unanimous approval from the board.

Chairman DeBerry read a devotional on happiness.

Chairman DeBerry led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

No one signed up to address the board during the public comment period.

Superintendent Ellis recognized Mitch Taylor, Chief Financial Officer. Mr. Taylor completed the North Carolina Association of School Business Officials Finance Director Academy. Dr. Ellis thanked Mr. Taylor for his hard work dedication and the time and effort it took to complete the program.

Superintendent Ellis also recognized the finance office staff for receiving three awards: Excellence in Management of State Funds, Excellence in financial Reporting and Achievement in Financial Resource Management. Dr. Ellis thanked the staff for their team effort and for their work every day keeping the school finances in order. Accepting the award was Mitch Taylor, Lisa Ritter, Donna Morris, Cheryl Kime and Michelle Brady.

Chairman DeBerry asked the board for permission to move the consent agenda to closed session. The board approved unanimously.

Superintendent Ellis asked the board to open discussion on Policy #4601 Collection of Student Fees and Charges. The policy, adopted August 3, 2015, states that if students owe fees for textbooks, extracurricular and/or athletic supplies, fundraiser balances, damages to laptops and cafeteria charges, they must be paid in full by the end of the current school year. In the event the fees cannot be collected, the administration may withhold the student from end of the year ceremonies, including graduation exercises. Over the past two board meetings, feedback has been gathered and changes have been made to this policy. A letter discussing school system changes, a signature page, a copy of the new policy and the poverty guidelines for 2018 (for fee waiver) will be given to parents at open house. This year there will be a technology fee of twenty-five dollars for kindergarten through second grade and forty dollars for third through twelfth grade. This includes insurance to cover each device. The final policy change is to be approved at the September board meeting.

Dr. Ellis presented a formal resolution to the board concerning the Field House at Montgomery Central. The resolution asks the county to work with the USDA to find any allowances or other contingencies to apply to the fieldhouse budget. Bryan Dozier made the motion to approve with Shirley Threadgill seconding. The board approved the resolution unanimously. The resolution reads as follows:

A Resolution

WHEREAS, Montgomery County is investing significant resources in the construction of a new Montgomery Central High School and a new CTE Center, to include both state-of-the-art academic and athletic facilities; and

WHEREAS, the construction budget realizes a deficit as it relates to the construction of a necessary field house to be utilized for athletic purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County School system has expended much effort and personnel resources to first take care of the academic needs of students as it relates to the construction project, both in the building design and in the focus on equipping the buildings with the best available educational resources; and

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County School system feels comfortable that such effort will meet the future academic needs of the County relative to job preparation and serve the future needs for Economic Development for the County at-large; and

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners has asked if such additional funds to properly finish the field house building as originally designed could be realized in the Furniture, Finishes, and Equipment (FF&E) budget and such funds are not available in the said FF&E budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT the Montgomery County Board of Education and Superintendent of Schools respectfully requests that the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners work with the United States Department of Agriculture (as the funding source for the project) and within the existing construction budget to identify areas in the said budget, to include any allowances, any areas of cost savings, and/or any other contingency budgets, to fully fund the necessary field house as originally designed, to the end that the field house can be completed as designed without compromising the academic needs of students.
