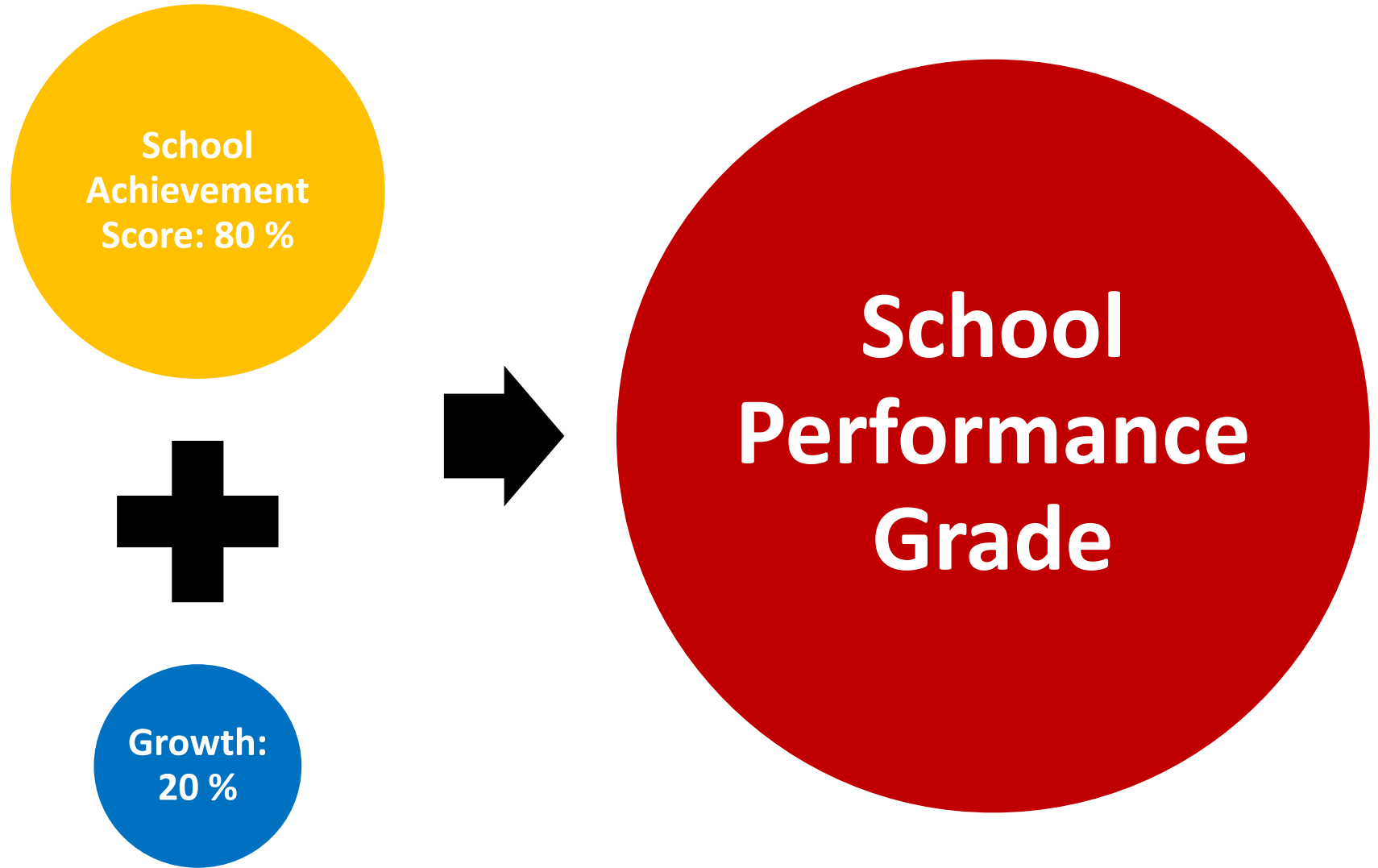

# School Growth

- ***EVAAS® School Accountability\* Growth***
  - Includes
    - End-of-Grade Tests
    - End-of-Course Tests
  - Reported for each school as having
    - Exceeded Growth
    - Met Growth
    - Not Met Growth
- **If a school has met expected growth and inclusion of the school's growth score reduces the school's performance score and grade, a school may choose to use the school achievement score solely to calculate the performance score and grade.**

# Calculation

A method established by the State Board of Education will convert each school's point total into a corresponding score on a 0-100 point scale; various ranges on the point scale continuum then translate to a letter grade as follows:

2013-2014 Data (15 point scale)	2014-2015 Data (10 point scale)
85-100 = A 70-84 = B 55-69 = C 40-54 = D 0-39 = F	90-100 = A 80-89 = B 70-79 = C 60-69 = D 0-59 = F
