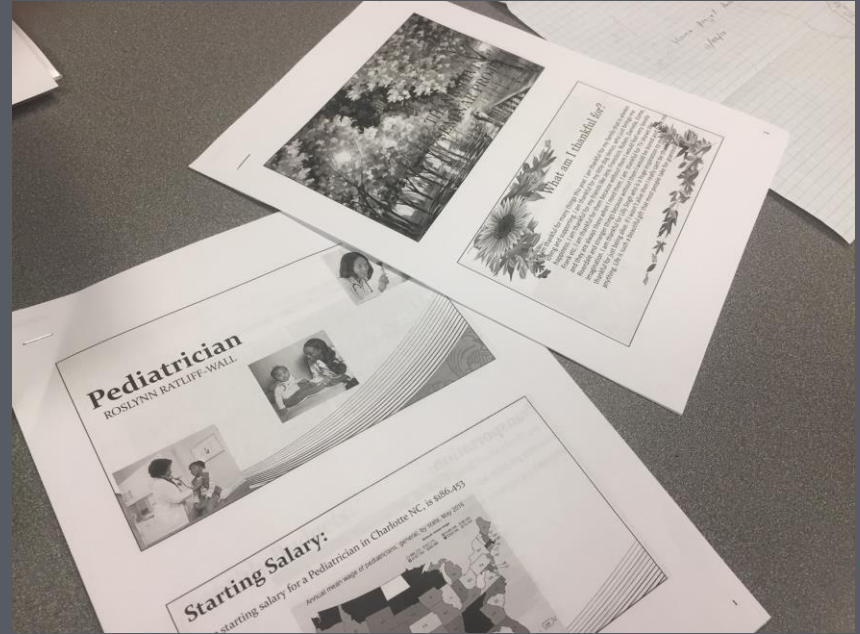

- Positive reinforcement of the growth mindset



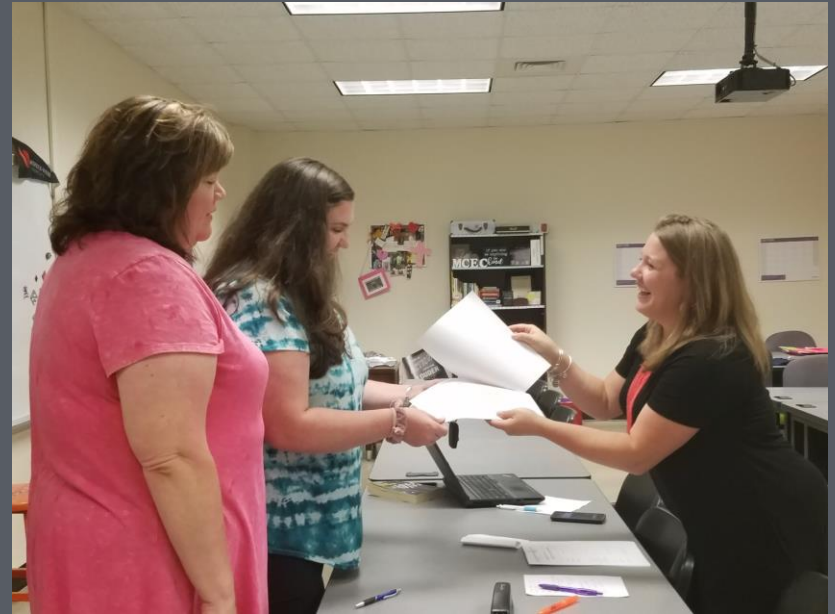
Teacher Perspective
