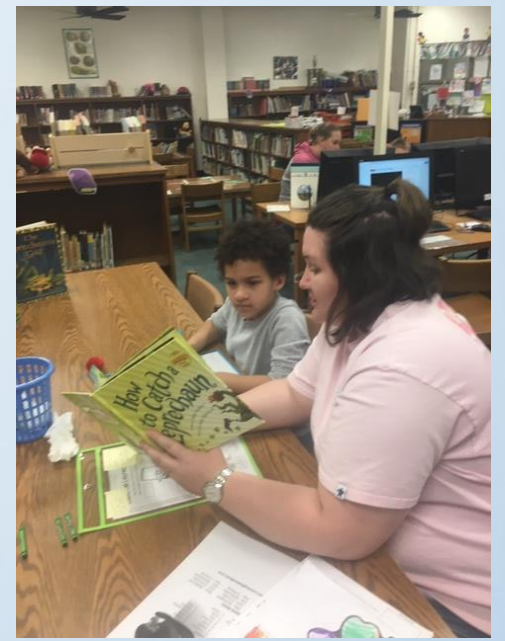




IAL Grant Update

August 5, 2019



Year 1 Accomplishments to date

- 18 Little Free Libraries throughout the county.
- Mobile Literacy Bus has been purchased and will be refurbished for usage throughout the county.
- Family Engagement Specialists were hired in November and work in all Elementary schools
- Elementary Media Specialist was hired in February to assist Media Assistants with lesson planning and media collections.
- Elementary/Middle Schools have extended media hours. (afterschool, 1 Saturday per month, summer hours)
- Summer Camp for PreK and K students for 8 days in June.

Year 1 Accomplishments to date

- Elementary and middle school media centers received \$7000 each for media collection updates. More funding for 2 more years.
- All students in grades PreK-6th have received at least 5 books since December, 2018.

December, 2018 until July, 2019

14,927 books have been distributed to MCS students.

Year 2 and 3

Received approval from US DOE to shift monies and create new Digital Learning/STEM Assistant positions at Elementary schools

\$7000 additional for media collections each year

Continue book distributions at schools, parent and community events.

Saturday Media Center activities will be STEM based.

Mobile Literacy Lab will focus on getting in the communities and having books available for students.
