Our operations have efficiently removed approximately 6,704 tons nationally, and 1,676 tons locally, of textiles from our waste stream every year.







Questions and Answers



Where do the materials collected end up?

Our program is different than most. The materials we collect are repurposed and reused for the benefit of the local community before ever reaching foreign markets or being processed for recycling.

Does this impact other local charities?

NO. You have to study the numbers given to us by the EPA. Out of the enormous amount of textiles created every year only 15.3% are collected. This program is designed to target the 84.7% that continues to enter our landfills. Programs like this have proven to increase awareness of the need to recycle textiles and may increase donations for other organizations.

Who maintains my program?

Each program is managed locally allowing us to provide daily service until a maintenance schedule can be developed to ensure the appearance of the bins and the area around them.
