

# HIGH SCHOOL TRAINERS


A partnership with First Health to  
provide trainer to East Montgomery  
High School

- ▶ I met with a doctor and the head trainer at Pinecrest High School about two weeks ago to discuss a partnership with them to provide trainers to our school system.






For the last three or four years  
we have struggled to find a  
trainer to be on site for all  
practices and games  
at both schools.  
It is required for  
football and wrestling.

- ▶ In the first year , First Health would provide the salary for both positions (around the starting salary for a beginning teacher)
  - ▶ Our responsibility would be to provide funding for supplies and a trainer's room. Also we would provide benefits for the two employees.
  - ▶ They would work the first half of the day with First Health and then start working with us around 2:00 each day. They would be responsible for being around at all athletic events for each school.

- ▶ In the second year of the program, Montgomery County Schools would be responsible for the salary of one of the trainers and the benefits for both.
- ▶ In the third year of the program, they would become our employees. At this time, they could teach classes for us during the day and be the full-time trainer.



- ▶ This is another opportunity for us to partner with First Health and they are willing to provide this to both high schools.
  - ▶ It is our belief that we need these services as concerns with concussions, the use of AED's and other sports related injuries have become a common concern through out the United States.
