

## What is required to operate an After-Care Site?

- Attend Pre-licensing training----done
- · Have fire, building, and sanitation inspections -----done
- Submit application, floor plan, criminal record check qualification letter----done
- · Rules review with Lead Child Care Consultant
- · Begin setting up room-per regulations
- Obtain final Approved building, fire, and sanitation inspections

## What is required to operate an After-Care Site?

- Complete required training----CPR, First Aid, Play Ground Safety
- Determine rates --- \$563 is the fulltime rate for Montgomery as determined by NCICDP-North Carolina Institute for Child Care Professionals
- Sites must have an Administrator that is on-site at least 80% of the time, teacher (not required to be a certified classroom teacher but there are other requirements), and teacher assistant—based on 19 kids per class
- Salaries of staff average between \$8-\$15 statewide
